- Applicants will be evaluated on the criteria of scholastic merit, honors, activities, character, choir involvement, skills, and two reference letters.
- The two letters of reference consist of one non-family, non-school related personal reference (i.e. Boy Scout Troop leader, church leader, family friend), and one teacher or administrator reference.

 Do not ask either of the Choral Directors or the Voice Lesson Teachers for a reference. Attach the two letters of reference to the application.
- A Scholarship Committee will select the scholarship winners. The applications will have names removed prior to being given to the committee members.
- Scholarships will be made payable to the educational institution selected by the recipient to be used for the recipient's tuition, fees, and/or books.
